POSITION SUMMARY

The role of the Public Safety Officer is a fast paced position responding to Fire and EMS incidents. The Public Safety Officer's primary function is as a Fire Apparatus Drive/Operator during the fire/rescue emergencies for the two fire companies in Lower Allen Township (Lower Allen and Lisburn). The Public Safety Officer also provides assistance to EMS with patient care/handling at the scene of Emergency Medical incidents. The Public Safety Officer does provide assistance to Police Officers in handling of non-emergency law enforcement duties periodically.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

This position requires a high level of problem-solving ability, self-initiative, the ability and willingness to work a majority of the time without direct supervision, and the ability to accurately assess situations. The position requires the individual to report to the Fire Captain, but to interact with a variety of public safety disciplines at any time. Ability to maintain Fire, Rescue, and EMT certifications is essential. Successful performers are those who are capable of making independent decisions that are consistently in line with the agency's mission, goals and objectives.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS for PSO I (Full-Time \$17.37/hr.)

- 18 years of age.
- High School Diploma or equivalent GED.
- 3 years of structural firefighting experience and 100 hours of structural firefighting and/or rescue training, or an equivalent combination of experience and training.
- 2 years of fire apparatus Driver/Operator experience on Engines/Pumpers (Also Aerial Apparatus preferred).
- Firefighter I Certification (DOD, IFSAC or Pro Board).
- Hazardous Materials—Operations Level (Refresher within 1 year).
- ICS-100, ICS-200, IS-700 and IS-800 certificates.
- EMT Certificate (Pa or able to obtain PA certification within 90 days) with EMSVO Certificate.
- Current CPR/AED certification.
- PA State Driver's License (or out-of-state driver's license with the ability to obtain PA license within 30 days).
- Pump Operations I Certificate.
- Foam Firefighting — Basic Certificate (within six months of hire).
- Be qualified to drive and operate Squad 12 within three months of hire.
- The ability to pass a background and criminal investigation.
- Ability to communicate effectively and professionally in English both verbally and in writing.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS for PSO II (Full-Time) \$21.00/hr.)

- Meet all qualifications and requirements of a PSO, a Community Service Officers (CSO), and complete Lower Allen EMS orientation training program.
- Be qualified to drive and operate all Lower Allen Fire Company Apparatus (within nine months of hire).
- Be qualified to drive and operate all Lisburn Fire Company Apparatus (within twelve months of hire).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS for PSO III (Full-Time) \$23.00/hr.)

- Child Safety Seat Technician Certification (Safe Kids Worldwide) (obtain within 18 months of hire).
- Firefighter II Certification (DOD, IFSAC or Pro Board) (obtain within 18 months of hire).
- Fire Inspector I Certification (DOD, IFSAC or Pro Board) (obtain within 20 months of hire).
- PA Department of Labor and Industry UCC Fire Inspector Certification (obtain within 22 months of hire).
- ICC International Property Maintenance Code Certification (obtain within 24 months of hire).
- PA DOH Vehicle Rescue Technician (BVR Awareness and Operations) (obtain within 24 months of hire).
