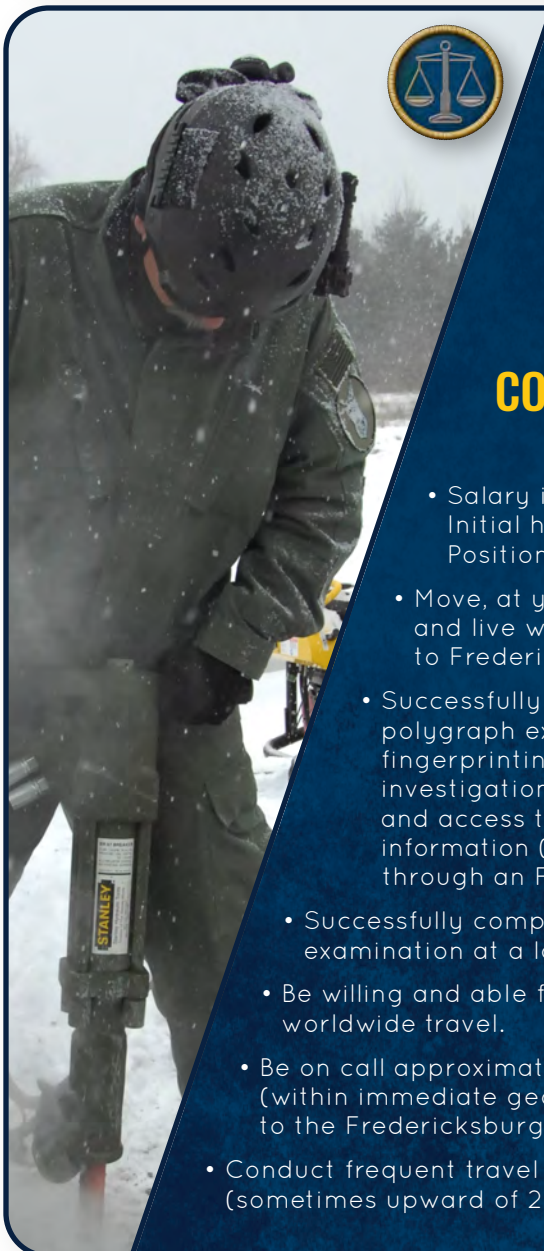

- Salary is dependent upon experience. Initial hiring range is between GS-9-11. Position tops out at GS-13.
- Move, at your own expense, to Virginia and live within commuting distance to Fredericksburg, Virginia.
- Successfully pass a personal security interview, polygraph examination, drug urinalysis, fingerprinting, and full scope background investigation to obtain a top-secret clearance and access to sensitive compartmented information (SCI). This process will be driven through an FBI Field Office near you.
- Successfully complete an FBI provided medical examination at a location close to you.
- Be willing and able for immediate no-notice worldwide travel.
- Be on call approximately 66% of the time (within immediate geographic recall to the Fredericksburg, Virginia area).
- Conduct frequent travel (sometimes upward of 2 weeks per month).



# AN FBI CAREER IS ALL ABOUT DEDICATION

While working in the FBI is both challenging and rewarding, there are specific entry qualifications that must be met prior to onboarding.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Be able to obtain a Top Secret Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI) Clearance.
- Be in compliance with the FBI Employment Drug Policy.
- Have a bachelor's degree or higher from a U.S.-accredited college or university (negotiable dependent upon experience).
- Possess a valid driver's license.
- If currently on active duty in the military, be within 15 months of completing your service (with an honorable discharge) before submitting your application.

## AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFIERS

- Non-U.S. citizenship.
- Conviction of a felony.
- Violation of the FBI Employment Drug Policy.
- Default on a student loan insured by the U.S. government.
- Failure of an FBI-administered drug test.
- Failure to register with the Selective Service System (males only).
- Knowingly or willingly engaged in acts or activities designed to overthrow the U.S. government by force.
- Failure to pay court-ordered child support.
- Failure to file income tax returns.



## APPLICANT PROCESS

### 1 APPLICATION

### 2 INTERVIEW & SELECTION

Be aware that the hiring process can take a year or more.

### 3 CONDITIONAL JOB OFFER & BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

Once accepted, you will undergo an intensive background investigation.

### 4 FINAL JOB OFFER & ONBOARDING

Once accepted, new employees report to the Lab for onboarding.
